Greetings,

In the New American Standard Bible, 2 Timothy chapter 3 is subtitled 'Difficult Times Will Come'. The first section pretty well details much of what we see in the world today, and then the second section tells us how to stand against the tide of wickedness described. A key component of this program to keep one's light burning in the midst of increasing darkness is, as in Timothy's case, that he "...from childhood (has) known the sacred writings which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus."

I think this brilliantly highlights the truth that exposing our children to the Word of God is very important for their future. They may not grasp all that is being taught or desire this teaching, but they are not responsible for that decision, their parents/guardians are. Timothy's mother and grandmother are both mentioned by name in 2 Tim. 1:5. So, with what opportunity we have, let's be about the Master's business, investing resources in the spiritual training of our children.


You probably know that this consists primarily in regular church attendance, Sunday school and youth group participation and family prayer/Bible reading. God knows we are all pretty busy — and so He is honored with whatever sacrifice it takes for us to draw near to Him, being a 'rewarder of those who seek Him'. Chapter 3 ends with this declaration: "All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness, so that the man (or woman) of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work." What a loving gift to give our children, that they can be 'equipped for every good work'!



Our next meeting will be February 8th from 6-8 pm. We welcome and appreciate any meal contributions for our gatherings.




