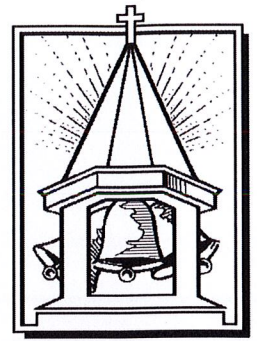

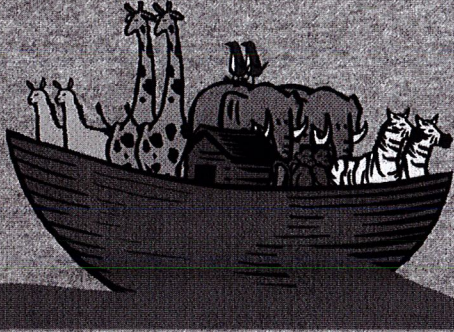
We look forward to seeing you on Sunday mornings this year for our Sunday School for all ages.

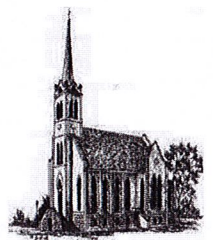
### BUSY BAGS IN CHURCH

### Church Renovation Update

At a called congregation meeting on May 20, 2018 our congregation took a huge step in approving the construction of the elevator renovation at a cost of \$538,292 by an overwhelming majority vote. The contractor has approximately 175 days to complete the project. To date contributions of approximately \$265,000 have come in for the renovation. The contractor must be paid as work is completed so we encourage everyone to prayerfully consider giving generously to this project. As construction begins on our renovation project, please heed warnings and temporary fencing around the work area. The only usable entrance to the parish hall will be the back entrance (Stone Church side). There may also be inconveniences during construction of the bathroom.

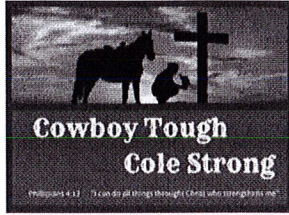

**CALL TO ORDER:** President Marv Sager called the meeting to order. Dickie Bettge opened the meeting with a devotion based on Daniel 2. God's got the whole world in His hands, the Nations and the Rulers as well.

Renovation Progress:

- Renovation started. A list of items was compiled to address construction issues with the contractor at our next construction meeting. The contractor was encouraged to complete the restroom as we do have a need for it on Sundays.
- Foundation issue. A change order for \$9684.56 was prepared to correct an unforeseen foundation problem. The existing foundation had a projection into the area that was needed for the new building. This projection needed to be removed. In order to maintain the stability of the existing foundation, doweling into the new foundation was required.
- Another change order for \$3592 was prepared for the doweling of the foundation and to correct some elevator issues. The elevator issues were challenged by the property team and Patrick, but could not be resolved without the change order.
- Construction Meetings scheduled with Roth. July 10, August 7, Sept. 11, Oct. 9, & Nov. 6.

**Organ repair and maintenance** – Talked to Shaun with Pipe Organ Technicians. He apologized for not getting back with us. Asked for a little more time to schedule a Meyersville visit. He has a very large organ, that was from a church damaged by Harvey

completely apart and is in the process of going back together with it. He said he hopes to be done in 3 weeks or so, and that he hopes we can appreciate his wanting to focus on that organ and get it up and running. I said yes as long as we get the same consideration when he's working on ours. He did say if something drastic happens to call.

**Church Security** – There is a Safety and Awareness committee in place working on several areas. We will keep Worship Team aware of actions that will impact the Worship service.
