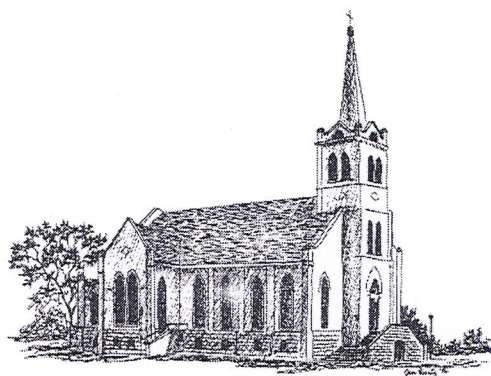

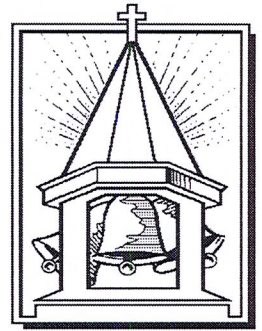

Greetings,

As I watch what is going on in the world today, I feel compelled by God to do this month's message on Love.

We talk often about love, but what does the Lord mean when He talks about love? How do you understand love? What is your definition?

God talks of love throughout scripture, but I believe we should start in the book of Ephesians to find the true "recipe" for expressing love. Ephesians 4 begins by urging for us to walk in the manner in which we have been called—with humility, gentleness and patience, standing together in love, with unity, with peace: "*with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love,<sup>3</sup> eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.*" Excerpt from Ephesians 4:1-3  
ESV

Later in verse 15, we're urged to "speak the truth in love," working to become more Christ-like in our dealings with each other. Finally, we're urged to **embrace our new life in Christ**, to put off our old self and to be renewed in the spirit of our minds. (verses 22-23)

The "recipe" ends with truths to help us love better, stronger and deeper:

Verse 25 tells us to speak the truth, verse 26 reminds us to be angry but don't sin and don't let the sun go down on your anger.

Verse 29 tells us to speak good things to each other, (no corrupting talk) and verse 31 give us great advice. Get rid of negativity! Put away bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, slander and malice.

And finally verse 32 gives us the best advice of all. A message that we all need to live by. Be kind and tenderhearted to each other! And finally, the cherry on top: be forgiving.

Paul tells us the importance of Love in 1 Corinthians 13. He starts with, "*if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing.*" And he ends the chapter with, "*So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love.*"

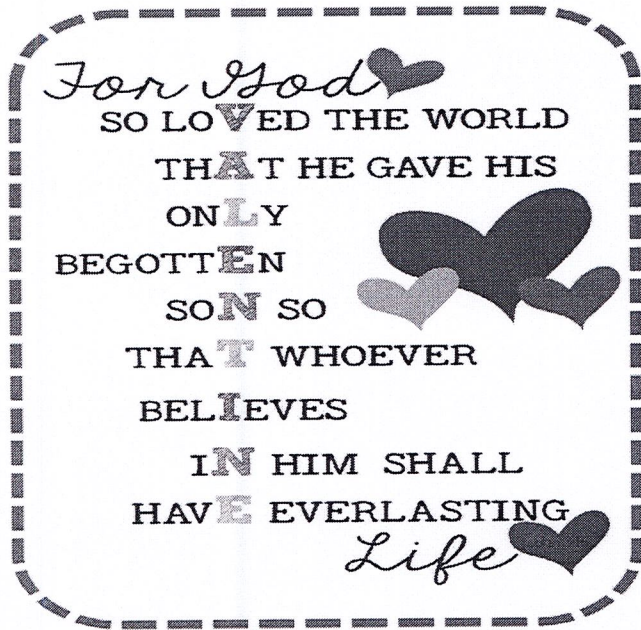
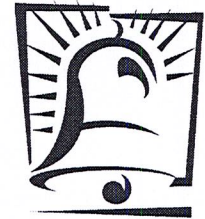
I pray that we all strive to show more love and to help spread love throughout the world.

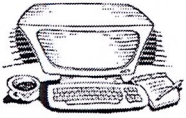

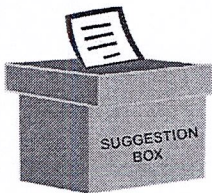

#### The Boys & Girls Club of DeWitt County Mission Statement

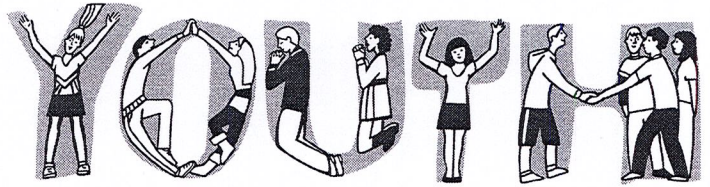

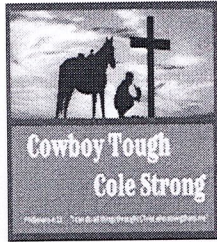
#### BUSY BAGS IN CHURCH

### Church Renovation Update

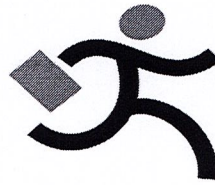


Our new bathroom is not quite complete, but the contractor is letting us use it until final finish work is completed. The contractor is in the process of pouring necessary concrete for the elevator shaft. The estimated costs for

construction, change orders, materials testing, architect, and incidentals is \$599,553. We are required to pay as construction progresses so the bills are coming in on a regular basis. This project received almost unanimous support so we ask that you prayerfully consider giving generously to this project.

### PARISH ED TEAM REPORT:

December 2018

Play Practice for the Christmas Eve program is in progress. We had 23 youth that signed up and participated.

Pastor John and I have been training new acolytes; Grace Redmond and MacKenna Diebel Coleman served on December 9th and Kendra Redmond and Jayden Pothoff served on December 16th.

### PROPERTY TEAM REPORT

12/20/18

Members: Dickie Bettge, Marv Sager, Vance Egg, Glenn Ruschhaupt, Clay Haun, Pastor John, Dwight Jander, Brent Gohmert.

Renovation Progress:

- Damp proofing of walls below ground level has been done.
- The slab and beam holding the stairway was poured on 12/17/18.
- The next pour will be the steps followed by damp proofing the walls above ground.
- The brick mason will follow to construct the walls which will be constructed from cinder blocks with brick veneer.
- Hopefully when we finish the concrete work, things will go faster.
- We have paid Roth \$223,443.46 with a balance remaining of \$328,125.10.
- We have paid RMA \$37,310.00 with a balance remaining of \$2,690.00.
- We have paid TSI (testing lab.) \$3,812.00 with a balance remaining of \$2,933.00.
- In the next week or so, we plan to trim the live oak tree next to the renovation project. Don't be alarmed if about half the tree is gone. We will trim it severely enough so trimming won't be necessary for at least several years.

Renovation Fund Balance: \$339,073. (12/9/18).  
We did not have a Property Team meeting in Dec.

## WORSHIP TEAM REPORT

The Worship Team did not meet in December, therefore no report.

### ADDITIONAL Discussion

There is a used piano for sale that could be used in the parish hall. After some discussion, it was decided that more information was needed in order to make a decision.

A motion was made to set the January meeting for Jan. 29, after the Annual Meeting. Motion was made by Johnny Jank and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Glenn Ruschhaupt. Motion passed.


