


St. John will be having a Memorial Day Service on Sunday, May 30, 2021.

CALL TO ORDER: Obert called the meeting to order.

OPENING DEVOTION: Charles read a passage from 2nd Timothy 13. Paul was talking to Young Timothy about the Church, and the importance of the Word of God as the central focus of the church.

Pastor Report

They will focus on restoring safe drinking water to the elderly, disabled, and uninsured in Texas as a result of the February weeklong freezing temperatures and power outages that caused many broken pipes.

The NALC Disaster Warehouse items for collection will be scrub brushes and scouring cleanser (ex. Comet)

We discussed how the phone prayer chain and the bulletin prayer requests could be united as one.

Pastor John had been contacted by David Snyder, Director of Program Ministries of Lutheran Bible Translators. He would like to meet with us April 23 to discuss a mission field in an Ethiopian seminary which is nearing completion.
